

## Sherman County 4-H Shotgun Shotgun State Qualifier • Trap and Skeet



Sunday, August 17, 2025 Goodland Gun Club • Goodland, Kansas

North of Goodland at intersection of Hwy 27 and North Caldwell

Skeet will start at 8:00 am (MST). Trap will start at 8:30 am (MST). Trap practice rounds will be offered between 7:30-8:15 am (MST). (\*\*Depending on number of skeet entries, some skeet squads may be scheduled for August 16th.)

## \$20.00 for Skeet and \$40.00 for Trap. \$7.00 Trap Practice Rounds.

- TRAP:100 clays (4 Rounds) at 16 yards with a state qualifying score being 35 hits out of 50, from the first 50 shots (2<br/>Rounds). 4 Rounds will be broken into two sessions. Individual tie breakers will be broken by shoot-offs<br/>starting at 21 yards and move back in 2-yard increments to 27 yards as needed. Each competitor will shoot<br/>two clays per station. Shoot-offs will be held immediately after the last squad of shooters. Current ATA and<br/>2025 Kansas State Match Rules apply.
- **SKEET:** 50 clays with a state qualifying score being <u>30 hits out of 50</u>. Tiebreakers use reverse order. Using the score sheet for hits and misses starting at the last target and counting to the first target, the shooter with the longest continuous run of hits wins the tiebreaker. Current NSSA and 2025 Kansas State Match Rules apply.

Participants must be 4-H age 10-18 before 1/1/25

## Awards

Junior Division (10-13) Senior Division (14 - 18) Overall Team

Awards will be given to the top three competitors in each division in both trap and skeet. Overall team scores will consist of grand aggregate of trap and skeet of the top 5 competitors from each county.

• Squad times will be emailed to contact listed on registration form prior to event. Only one person per county for event check in.

• Eye and ear protection required for anyone past the ready line. Audio headphones/earpieces will not be permitted on the firing line or range.

• Provide own shells. New shells not larger than 12 gauge with a maximum shot size of 7 1/2 lead shot and maximum shot charge of 1 1/8. NO RELOADS.

• No barrels resting on toes, foot, or pointed at any part of the body. A shell catcher must be used on semi-automatic shotguns.

• During each session, individuals should place second box of shells on table behind the scorer. A short break is allowed to retrieve the second box of shells and to hydrate. Individuals should not leave the range during the session.

• Concessions will be available.

• 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Clay Crusher Showdown 5-stand competition. This will be a separate event from qualifier. For all ages – Youth under 18 must have parent permission to participate.
