4-H Shooting Sports Match—Air Rifle, BB Gun, & Air Pistol

February 7, 2026—8:00 am

Sublette High School Gyms—501 Ellis—Sublette, KS

Registration form and fees are due by 5:00 pm on January 30, 2026. Late registrations will be accepted to ONLY fill relays. Fees are \$15 per shooter per discipline. Registration begins at 7:30 am. This is a State Qualifier for all disciplines. State match rules will be followed. Orion scoring system and targets will be used for all disciplines.

Air Rifle: Shooters will shoot 20 bull shots in each of 3 positions. Rules will follow the current CMP National Standard 3-position Air Rifle rule book. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each age group. **To qualify for the State Match in Air Rifle, the minimum individual score is 450 and the shooter must be at least 9 years old by 01-01-25.**

Age groups will be determined after registrations are submitted.

BB Gun: Shooters will shoot 10 bull shots in each of the 4 positions. Rules will follow the current Daisy National Match Program rules (NRA BB Gun Rulebook with some modifications). Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each age group. **To qualify for the State Match in BB Gun, the minimum individual score is 335 and the shooter must be at least 9 (by 01-01-25) - 15 (by date of match).**

Age groups will be determined after registrations are submitted.

Air Pistol: Shooters will shoot 40 bull shots in the standing position. Rules will follow the current NRA-USAS rulebook. Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in the Junior and Senior age divisions. **To qualify for the State Match in air pistol, the minimum individual score is 280 and the minimum 4-H age to participate is 10. We will be shooting paper targets only, no silhouettes.**

Age groups will be determined after registrations are submitted.
